## **ASSESSMENTS, GRADUATIONS ET AL.**

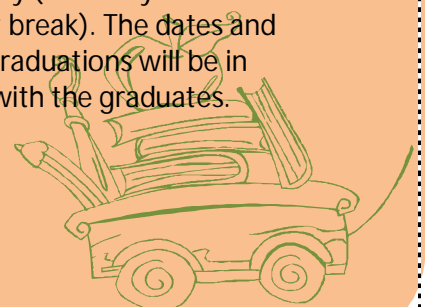
### **STUDENT INFORMATION**

We are still having issues with digital assessments. Sometimes you email them to the tutor, but they cannot be marked when in this form. Bernard has to "alter" them first, so make it easy on yourselves and email to the correct place the first time.

All submitted assessments are date stamped and logged to ensure we get them in on time. If yours is late you only get one further chance of assessment, and if it doesn't meet the requirements, then you fail that unit. You then have to do the whole thing over again later- don't be that person!

Students will now be graduating every six weeks. To ensure it is a non stressful and seamless process, your tutor will be reminding you to have all your assessments in on time. Marie will be monitoring your completion and ensuring that any issues are addressed quickly. Bernard will also be able to email you and/or print you a programme completion certificate, and Kauri record of Learning with your units and clinical hours when all your assessment have been marked and are competent.

Graduations will be in the 5<sup>th</sup> week after you finish your programme, and all assessments and reassessments must be in within two weeks of your last programme day (for many this will be after your last break). The dates and times of the graduations will be in consultation with the graduates.
